Along with the lunch menu that was sent home you should have also received two forms that need to be signed and returned to the office (photo release and handbook acknowledgement). Some of you received the fund raising packet at open house and others had it sent home with your child. If you have not received this or if you need extra copies please let me know and I will send it home with your child. Remember you may reorder magazines throughout the year on the website too.
