Helias High School Track and Field will sponsor summer youth track meets for ages 4-15. Age groups are in two year increments 4-5, 6-7, 8-9, 10-11, and so on. Ribbons will be awarded to the top 5 places for each age/sex group in each event. Age is determined by your age on that night. Cost of \$30 payable to Helias Track and Field will cover all 6 summer meets. You can pay \$5/night, but only the athletes who compete all six nights receive a t-shirt. The meets will start at 6:00 at Helias High School Track, every Tuesday and Thursday from June 1 to June 17 for a total of 6 meets.

We will have two field events each night alternating between shot and discus/high and long jump. All running events take place each night. Participants may enter a max of three events each night.

Athletes **MUST** be at least 6 years old to do High Jump and 1600m. Events will be in this order each night:

FIELD EVENTS –Long, Shot and Discus--Go to event any time during the evening—before 7:00pm (cafeteria style). High Jump will start at lowest height right after warm up. Age groups will be separated out at the events conclusion.

June 3—discus and high jump

June 8—shot and long jump

June 10—discus and high jump

June 15—shot and long jump

June 17—discus and high jump

Please, no pets allowed. Sign in and obtain a name tag each night. Parents escort your youngster to starting area, but then leave them with clerk to line up by age groups. Listen to the call for your running event/age group. Running events take precedent over field events. Please remember to bring water.
