2 trailers one to hold the main float the other to hold the younger kids to ride. We would need them a few days before the parade to set up if possible.

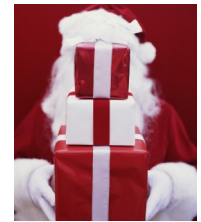
Any Military things. Some of the students will be dressed in Military uniforms and we would like anything we can borrow for those that might not have anything. Camoflauge clothing will work quite well.

People to work on putting the float together and to walk in the parade.

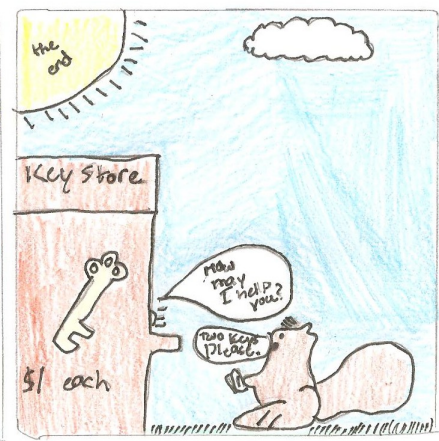
A couple of Parents that will help in the morning of the Parade with supplying maybe hot chocolate or tea to help keep the kids warm.
