We are having an October Bonanza on Box Tops please send them in during the month of October. The student that brings in the most gets a prize along with the class that brings in the most.

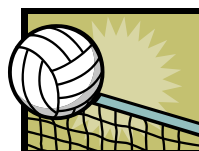

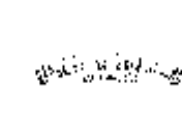
